Gross mass: 79.5t GML, 85.5t HML



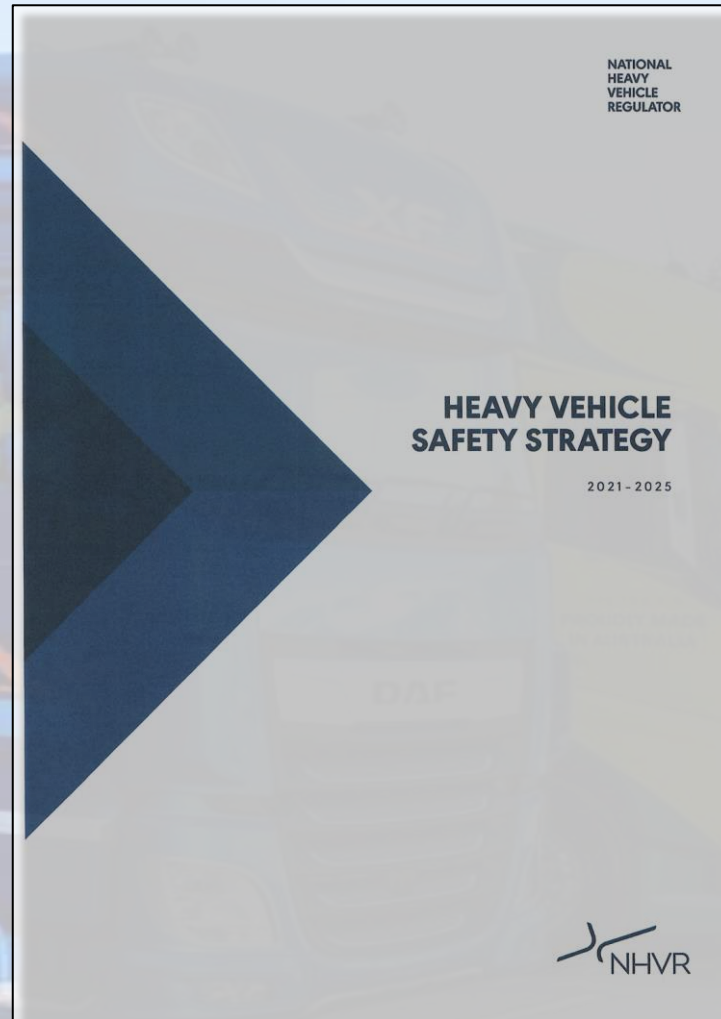
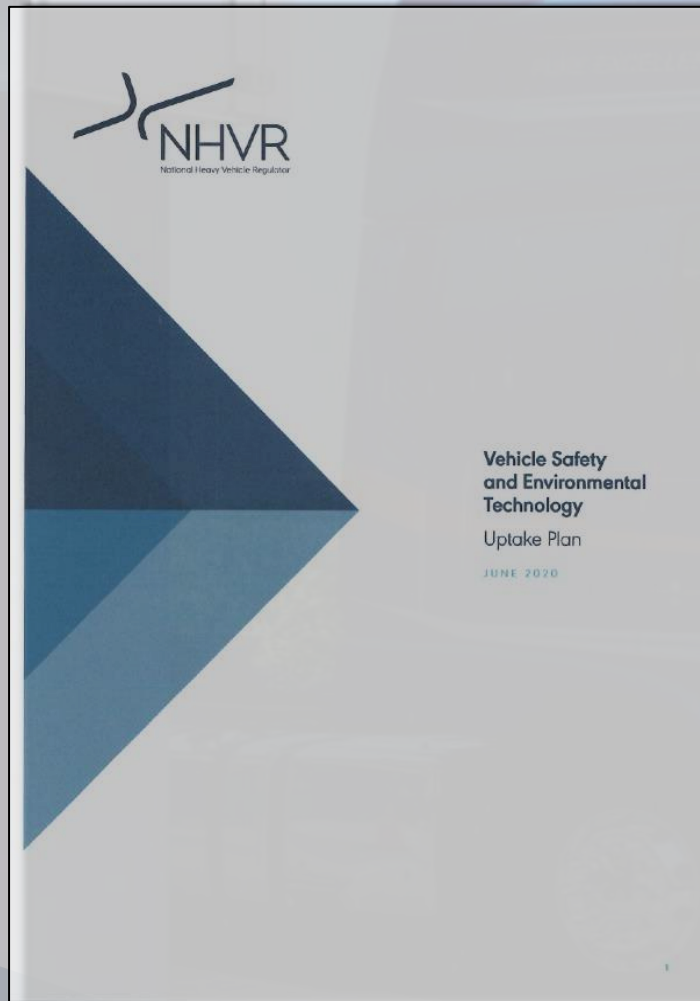
B-double

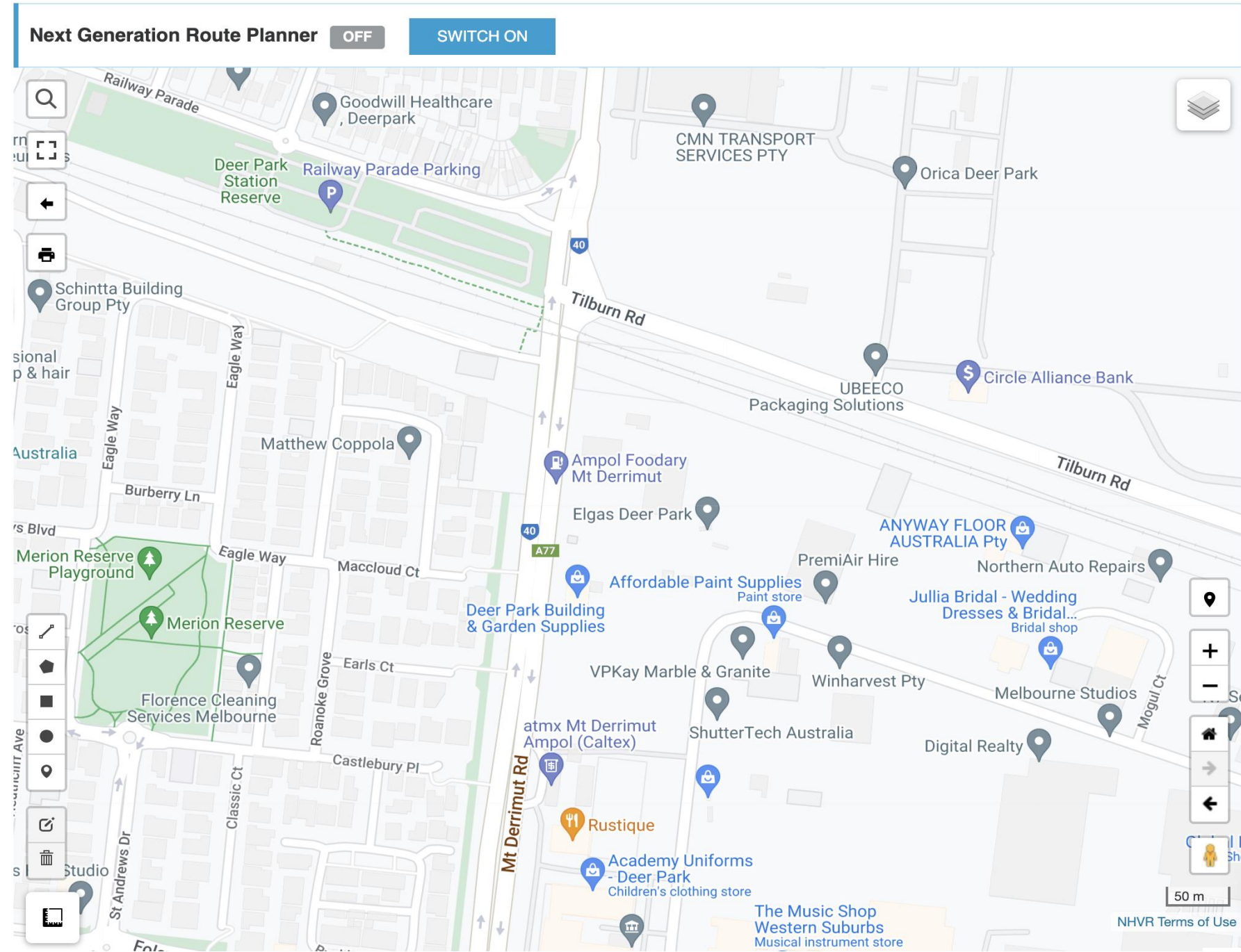

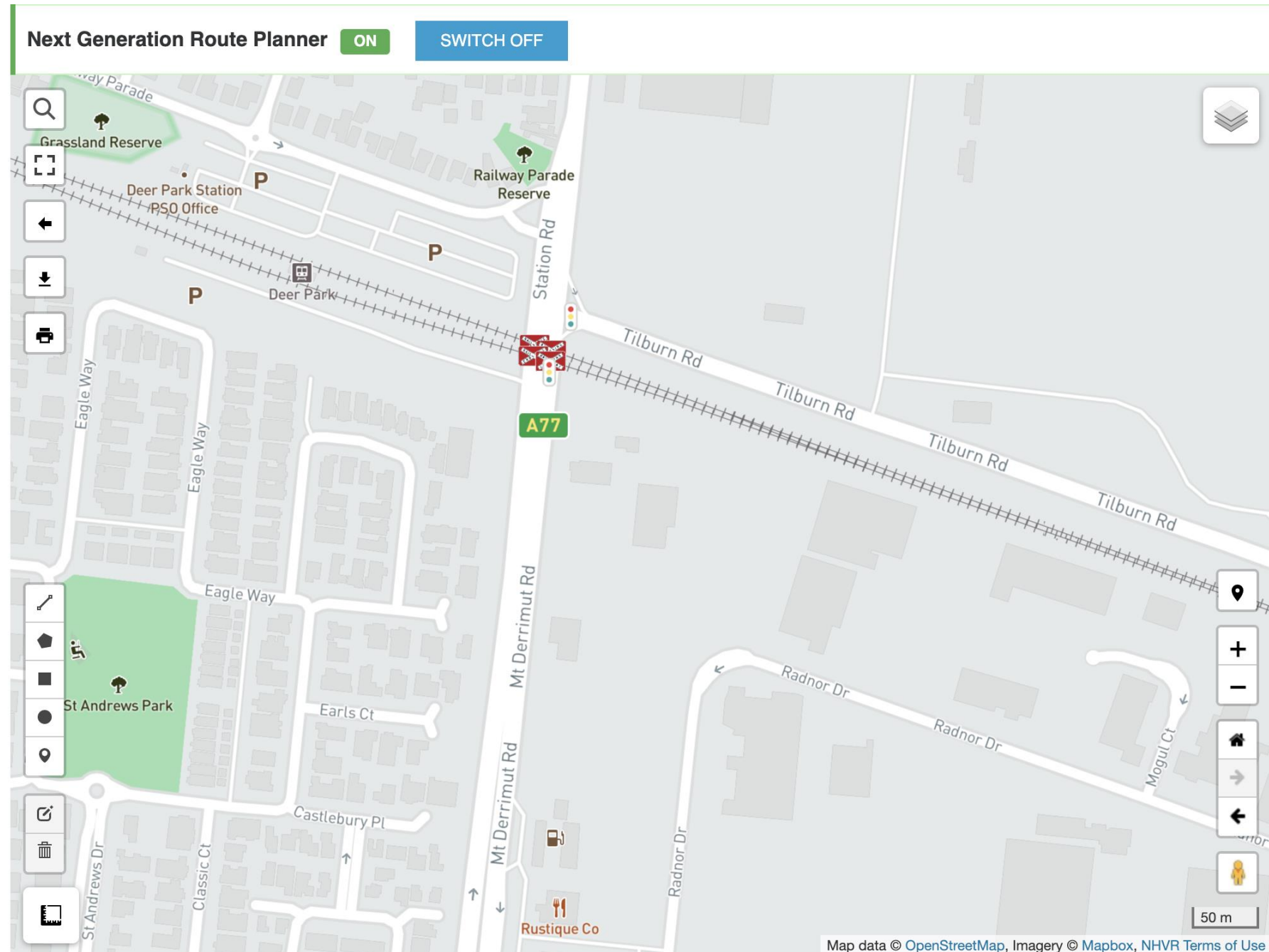

Railway crossings and traffic light intersections not highlighted



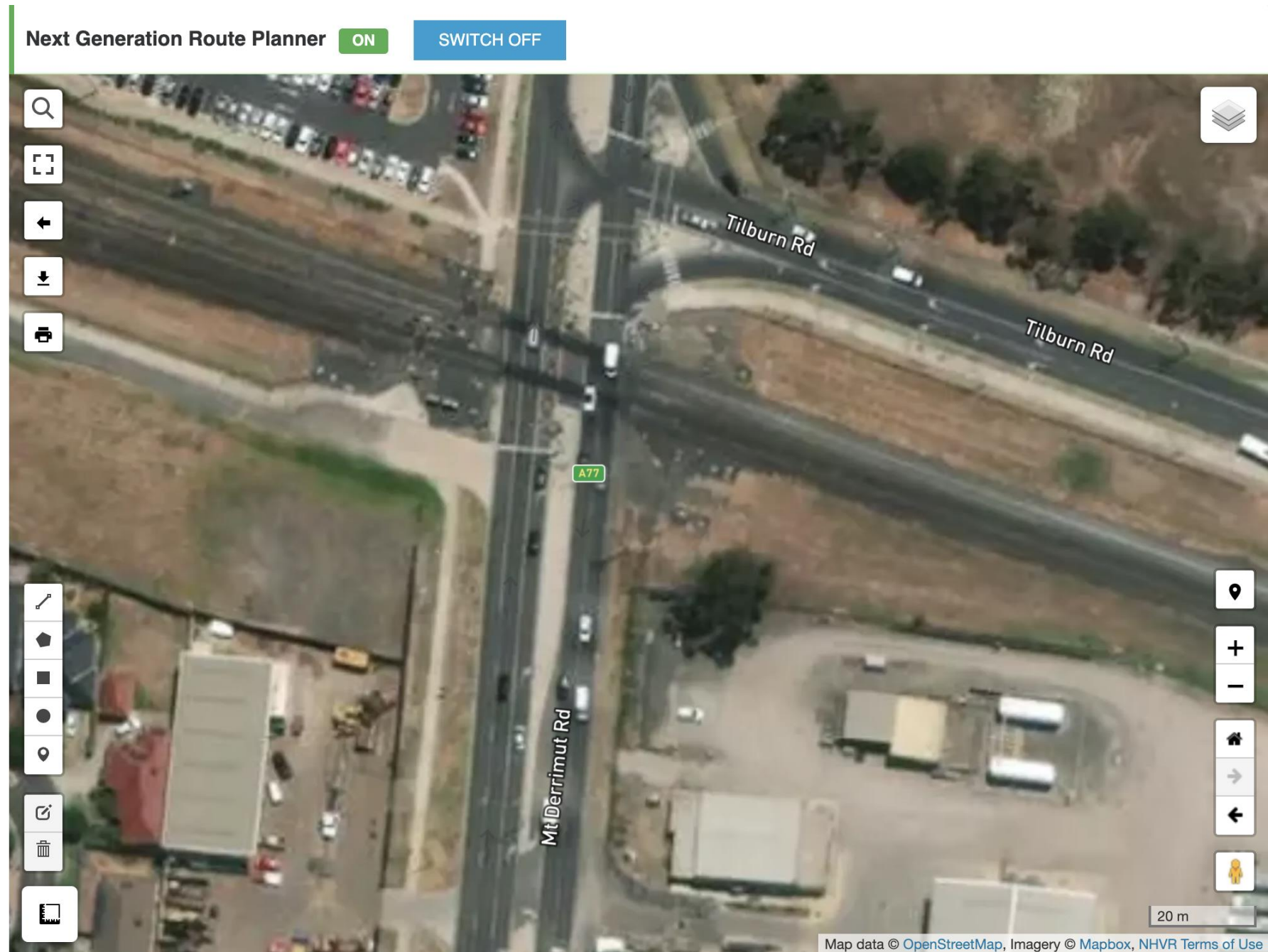
