There are 5 lessons, each focussing on one of the 5 key rail safety messages.

1 'STAND BACK behind the line!	2 'LOOK both ways for trains, trams and light rail' at rail crossings.	3 'LISTEN for trains, trams and light rail coming'.	4 'THINK - is it safe to cross?'	5 WHY do this for every rail space we visit?
